

## Holiday club policy for parents

Sunninghill offer a holiday club throughout each holiday on certain weeks (excluding half terms). This is open for children aged 3-13 and will be based in either the dining hall of the school or the main hall. The main playground and astro turf will also be used when the weather permits.

The pricing is £37.50 for a full day (8.15-5.30) and £22.00 for half a day. This can be morning or afternoon (8.15-1.30 or 1.30-5.30). There will be a 'late collection' charge of £10 per child for the first 15 minutes after 5.30pm, increasing to £15 per child for every 15 minutes after 5.45 pm.

For a child to be officially booked in booking forms, terms and conditions and payment must be received.

Electronic devices (including mobile phones) and own toys must not be brought into holiday club as we cannot guarantee their safety especially on days out. There is a holiday club mobile which parents can phone throughout the day (07708917494).

We encourage healthy eating at holiday club, this is done by having different fruits and vegetables at snack time however there is sometimes a tuck shop which children can buy treats from for 50p. Water is available to children throughout the day. Parents need to provide a packed lunch and water bottle. The children are encouraged to eat sandwiches or alternative first and then fruit or alternative. Please do not give your child sweets, solid chocolate or fizzy drinks (KitKats, breakaways e.t.c. are allowed) in their lunch, they will not be allowed to eat it, if a fizzy drink is brought in they will be provided with water. If you provide you child with grapes please could you cut them in half due to choking hazards. We run a nut free holiday club. When going on trips please avoid any food that could attract wasps and bees.

Please dress your child for the weather as well as bringing coats and sun cream each day. Could you also note when we are going on trips so your child is dressed appropriately including sun cream and hat. During the summer the pool will be open to holiday club and children will need to bring costumes and towels.



When dropping your child off the holiday club will not be open until 8.15 and children will not be supervised until then. Children must be brought to the door for parents to sign them in and then signed out at the end of the day. For trips, children must have arrived by the stated time on the activity plan, if not we will leave without the child. Please ring if you think you might be late.



## **Holiday Club Terms and Conditions**

I/We HEREBY DECLARE individually and jointly that:

- Terms and Conditions: I/we have read and understood and I/we agree to the School's Terms and Conditions listed below and the holiday club policy for parents available on the website. I/we have retained a copy of the Terms and Conditions for our records.
- Disabilities, Special Educational Needs & Learning Difficulties: I/we have provided details of any disability, special educational need or learning difficulty (for example, dyslexia, dyspraxia, attention deficit disorder, visual or hearing impairment or any condition requiring the use of a wheelchair) of my child in the attached form
- Medical Matters: I/we attach in confidence all relevant information about any medical condition, health problem, dietary requirement or allergy which affects our child and/or which may prevent our child from taking full part in the Holiday Club's activities and excursions.
- 4 **Confirmation of Declarations:** I/we confirm that the declarations made on this Form are true and that I/we have disclosed all information required in the declaration. I/we understand and agree that the School has the right to terminate this agreement if any declaration is found to be untrue.
- 5 **Start Time/Late Collection:** I/we understand that the morning drop off time is 8.15am at the earliest and that Sunninghill Prep School cannot accept any responsibility for safety of our child before 8.15am as there is no staff supervision available. I/we understand that if we fail to collect our child by 5.30pm a discretionary late collection penalty of £10 will be chargeable for the first 15 minutes after 5.30pm. Increasing to £15 per child for every 15 minutes after 5.45pm. This amount will be billed to you separately.
- 6 **Cancellation:** I/we understand that all bookings are subject to 24hrs notice of cancellation. Failure to cancel 24hrs prior to the booking will incur the full charge.
- 7 **Transport:** I/we consent to my/our child taking part in activities and visits which do not involve an overnight stay or travel abroad and I/we consent to my/our child being carried by public transport or school transport driven in a responsible manner by an adult who is suitably qualified and insured.



- 8 **Contact Information:** I/we have provided two contact numbers for the Holiday Club to use in the event we need to be contacted. We understand that in the event of an emergency all possible effort will be made to contact us as soon as possible.
- 9 **Swimming:** I/we give permission for my/our child to swim during holiday club if I/we have been given prior notification of the activity.
- Photos: I/we give permission for my/our child to be photographed for sole use by the school for marketing purposes.
- Sun screen: I/we give permission for holiday club staff to apply sun cream to my/our child if they are unable to do so themselves. I/we understand that I/we must supply our own sun cream. If the staff consider my/our child to not be adequately protected from the sun, they may be restricted from outdoor activities.

The School reserves the right to refuse or withdraw places in the Holiday Club if a child's behaviour is deemed unacceptable by the Holiday Club Supervisor.
