Full time nursery fees are calculated based on the 51 weeks of the year that Little Robins Nursery is open. Monthly payments will include bank and public holidays as well as inset days, which are payable in full in spite of closure, as our monthly staffing costs remain the same.

The Government has recently introduced new funding for eligible 2 year olds from April 2024, and for 9-23 month olds from September 2024. We have updated our fee table above to incorporate these.

# Frequently Asked Questions

## **What are the minimum number of sessions I can book?**

*There is a minimum session booking commitment for all children of 3 full days for full time places and 4 full days for term time places. Bookings must be made for the same sessions each week.*

## **If I want to change my sessions, how much notice do I need to give?**

*Due to staffing, we require as much notice as possible for a change in sessions – preferably a terms notice for term time places, and 2 months for full time places.*

## **What is included in the fees?**

*Fees include all meals (including a cooked lunch and snacks in the morning and afternoon) specialist lessons during term time and nappies (where relevant).*

## **Can I collect my child earlier than 6pm?**

*Yes, but the day rate and the afternoon rate is the same, even if you collect earlier.*

## **How often will I be invoiced?**

*You will be billed on a termly basis if term time and a monthly basis if all year round.*

## **Will I still need to pay if my child is sick or away on holiday?**

*Yes. Unfortunately there can be no refunds for sickness or holidays.*

## **If I am term time only, but I need some cover in the holidays, can I book my child in with you?**

*If we have space in our nursery during the holidays you are welcome to book in with our Nursery Managers, and places will be offered on a first come first served basis. The day fee will then be charged for the session booked.*

## **How much notice do I need to give if I want to leave?**

*A terms notice for term time places and 2 months notice for a full time place.*

## **I am interested in registering my child at Little Robbins Nursery. What happens next?**

*Please come in to meet the team and have a look around our nursery and we will let you know what places are available for your child. If a place is available you will receive an offer letter, together with our admission forms, and we ask you then to pay our registration fee of £75 and a deposit of £100 to secure your place. This deposit is refunded in full, less any unpaid charges, once a child leaves Little Robbins Nursery.*

*For children moving into Reception, an additional deposit of £500 is required to confirm their place.*

*Fees for nursery are continually reviewed and any charges will be publicised with a terms notice before implementation.*
