Sport

Sport features very strongly in the academic diet of all our children.

We have excellent facilities that include a heated outdoor pool that is in constant use in the warmer months, an all-weather pitch and multi-purpose grass pitches.



We are lucky enough to regularly visit the Andrew Simpson Sailing Centre and OTC Watersports at Weymouth and Portland National Sailing Academy for sailing, windsurfing and powerboating.

While many sports at Sunninghill feature combined boys and girls teams, as well as



many fixtures, the major sports for boys are football, rugby, hockey and cricket and for girls they are hockey, netball and rounders.

Fixtures take place against local schools on Tuesday and Wednesday afternoons and tasty match teas always follow when we play at home.

Music And Performing Arts

We believe that having a strong focus on music and performing arts compliments our pupils’ learning and greatly enhances school life at Sunninghill.

Individual music lessons are offered from Form 1 and most children in school learn at least one instrument.

Our pupils regularly take Associated Board of the Royal Schools of Music (ABRSM) examinations and have lots of opportunities to perform in public within school.

They can also take London Academy of Music and Dramatic Arts exams (LAMDA) and we are a registered site for these exams.

We delight audiences with events which include our regular music concerts, Nativity, Sunninghill’s Got Talent and whole school productions such as *Aladdin*, *Moana*, *Lion King* and *Joseph and The Amazing Technicolor Dreamcoat*. These include all the children on stage with costumes and props made by ourselves.

Enrichment And Clubs

We believe that enrichment activities are incredibly important in our pupils' development and as a result, a full programme of activities takes place every Friday afternoon.

This can include cookery, eco schools, sailing,



windsurfing, debating, badminton, archery and much more.

If you are visiting us in person, Sunninghill Prep School is located in the heart of the county town of Dorchester, on South Walks Road.

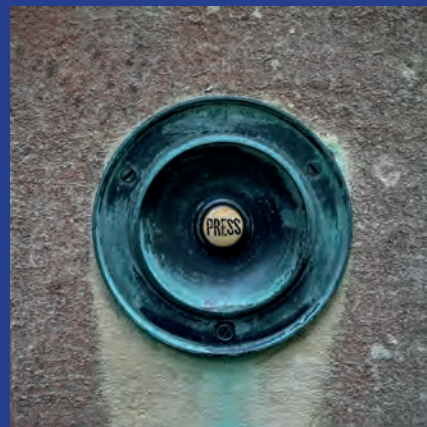
Our central location is within easy walking distance of the amenities in the town centre.

If you are travelling by car, Dorchester can be reached via the A35 from the east or the west and by the A37 from the north.

All vehicular access is via our entrance on Culliford Road where there is ample visitor car parking.

If you are travelling by train, the nearest stations are Dorchester South and Dorchester West, both just a nine minute walk from our school.

Trains from these stations travel direct to London, Bristol and Weymouth.
